

National Curriculum Levels from School Report Summer Term 2006



Annotation in this blue font shows raw data variables:

All having values 1-8 as indicated below.

Raw variable names ending in "1" and "2" refer to elder and younger twin respectively.

The data were collected from the parent and therefore are identified by family identifier FamilyID in the raw data.

Annotation in this red font shows dataset variables.

Note that there were negligible responses at levels 1 and 8, so dataset variables have values 2 to 7 (2=level 2 or lower, 7=level 7 or higher).

Dataset variables are double entered in the usual way, so names ending "1" and "2" refer to twin and cotwin respectively, not to elder and younger twin.
