Second Language Acquisition Study

What is it about?

We would like to invite you to take part in study investigating second language acquisition. This project is part of the Twins Early Development Study (TEDS) led by Professor Robert Plomin. The aim is of the study is to uncover variables that contribute to individual differences found in learning a second language and uncover why people might learn differently to each other.

How do we take part?

This study involves using the popular language learning software Rosetta Stone. You will be required to complete the first unit of the programme in German which will **take on average between 3-5 hours.** This unit is divided into 4 main sections; each comprising of one 'core lesson', which takes between 20-30 minutes, and small subsections which specialise in the different components of language (pronunciation, vocabulary, listening, grammar, writing and speaking), each taking less than 10 minutes. We recommend you try to **complete a section a week**. The deadline for completing the study is **10**th **September**.

We are interested in the differences in how individuals learn a second language therefore **ONLY COMPLETE EACH ACTIVITY ONCE.** Please do not try to improve your score by re-doing any of the activities.
